Rtn. Peter Humphrey announced that on August 17, former Olympic Pole Vaulting Gold Medal winner Sergey Bubka and a number of Rotarians visited Sun Children's Village. Sergey's second visit to the Village of this year drew media attention to the program, resulting in stories in the local press and China Daily. Sun Village was created in 1996 by Zhang Shuqin, after she retired as a corrections officer. Sun Village currently has four centers serving over 200 children in different areas of China. The centers provide housing, food, medical care and education for the children of prisoners or those executed. The Rotary Club of Beijing has been supporting the Beijing Sun Village for the last seven years and has provided funds and volunteer hours to build an eight person residence, a sports facility, a heating system as well as activities to get the children out and about. While chatting with the staff, Peter discovered that the Village urgently needs help preparing students for the transition to the workplace. For more information please contact Rtn. Guest Keith and Cheryl Wyse gave a short speech about their organization, Bread of Life Bakery, which provides shelter and care for children with orthopedic disabilities. Their program provides the specialized care they need and teaches them baking as a trade. Their organization is based in Langfang but they hope to create more facilities in Beijing and Tianjin. They currently take orders in Beijing once a week for home styled baked breads, cookies, brownies and pies which are made by their apprentices, all profits are used to pay current expenses and help more children.
